Department Head Report

Just like the Fiscal Court, our office continues to experience a continued increase in costs for payroll and benefit, while revenues stay stagnant at best. The State reimbursement rates for Voter Registration haven't been adjusted since 1974/1984. We haven't witnessed fee increases on the Motor Vehicle side of the office in decades. While our county has grown, the size of the office staff has decreased due to these concerns, however, this has caused increased wait times. Lonly give raises to those that warrant a raise but only when I have the fees to do so since our office pays for their own salaries and benefits. While many counties our size have several new car dealers and many more used, we are at a deficit on both. We continue to witness our own friends and family buy out of town and not demand their work be sent to their own county clerk which is allowed by the law. The average vehicle transfer loss to this is over \$ 100.00, resulting in thousands of lost revenues yearly. While we are fortunate to have Copart, most of their work is done at a loss or breakeven point. For example: we process more Junk Titles than any county in the state at \$ 1.00 per vehicle. It costs between \$ 2.00 and \$ 3.00 to complete this task. The more we process the more we lose. There are several other fees that are similar. Our saving grace had been a substantial increase in Land Recording fees that was implemented in 2021. However, the volume has slowed due to lack of houses and interest rates. There have been numerous attempts to increase the funding model for our offices but not much interest from Legislators, sighting, "I would lose the next election if I voted for fee increases". The KCCA Transportations Committee has met with both the House and Senate Transportation Committee Chairs regarding alternate means to solve this decades long problem. I am fortunate to Chair that committee and will continue to provide statistics and fight for those increases. We will be informed the leadership of KACo, KCJEA and KMCA regarding this issue and will be soliciting their help as we move forward. Remember, each dollar collected has a substantial impact on our office as well as yours whether in monthly checks or excess fees.
