## **Activity Report**

JULY 1, 2025

 After being officially sworn in, Director Shuttleworth uploaded all required new appointment documents to the Kentucky Emergency Management (KyEM).

July 2, 2025

 Uploaded Department of Emergency Services (DES) meeting documents to KyEM. In addition, began coordination with Federal Signal to schedule maintenance for the county's outdoor warning sirens.

July 3, 2025

 Director Shuttleworth and Anderson County Fire Chief Womack met with Jason Conley of Bad Company Pyro to discuss preparations and safety measures for the upcoming July 4 fireworks show.

July 4, 2025

 Director Shuttleworth prepared the County Park for the fireworks show by placing barricades in designated areas to limit public access for safety. Later that day, Director Shuttleworth, in collaboration with the City of Lawrenceburg Fire
 Department, responded to a gas leak reported by employees at the AT&T store. That evening, Director Shuttleworth was stationed at County Park during the fireworks event to oversee safety operations.

July 5, 2025

 Director Shuttleworth removed barricades and conducted cleanup operations at the County Park during the morning following the July 4 event. July 8, 2025

 Worked on-site with Federal Signal technicians at each outdoor warning siren location throughout the county to review and discuss maintenance needs specific to each site.

July 9, 2025

 Conducted an on-site assessment visit to Gilbert's Creek alongside Angela Drew from FEMA.

July 10, 2025

 Responded, in cooperation with the Anderson County Fire Department, the Anderson County Sheriff's Office and Anderson County EMS, to a vehicle accident involving a diesel pump at the BG/127 Truck Stop.

July 15, 2025

 Participated in a safety walkthrough of the YKK facility together with members from the Anderson County Fire Department, Anderson County EMS, and the City of Lawrenceburg Fire Department.

# Anderson County EMS - Department Head Report

## Personnel Update

- Orientation for our four new hires—Dakota Tackett, Matthew Jackson, Paul Davis, and Ashley McDaniel—is nearly complete. They are doing well, and we are proud to welcome them as part of our team.
- · We completed eight additional interviews and will be hiring:
  - 5 1 full-time AEMT
  - o 3 part-time EMTs

## Training & Documentation

- We completed a documentation training class with 911 Billing and the Chief of Pikeville FMS
- During the course, we learned that some long-standing practices need to be updated to ensure compliance.
- We are planning a joint meeting with Dispatch, the Police Department, and the Sheriff's Office to discuss these changes and improve documentation and communication procedures across agencies.

#### Employee Engagement

- The Command Staff prepared breakfast for EMS employees as a gesture of appreciation, and the event was well received.
- We also invited both fire departments and the police department to join us, continuing to build strong inter-agency relationships.

#### Equipment & Funding

- I met again with Stryker to discuss power lift stretchers and to secure the best possible pricing.
- We will soon begin a donation campaign to help fund these much-needed safety upgrades without relying on county funds.

#### Compliance & Safety

- · We conducted a risk assessment with VFIS, our insurance provider.
- The assessment showed that most areas are in compliance, and VFIS will assist us in developing corrective actions for any remaining deficiencies.

### Community & Partnerships

 I participated in a walkthrough of the YKK facility with EM, and both fire departments to improve familiarity with the site and better prepare for potential future responses.

### Closing Note

Anderson County EMS continues to build momentum through hiring, training, interagency coordination, and long-term planning. We appreciate the court's continued support as we grow stronger together.

## ORDINANCE # 2025-3

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANDERSON FISCAL COURT RELATING TO STREET-LEGAL SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, 2025 Ky. Acts ch. 89 (hereinafter "the Act") became law on March 26, 2025 and allows for the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on certain highways within the Commonwealth of Kentucky if allowed by ordinance of the local government within whose jurisdictional boundaries the highway is located; and

WHEREAS, the Act becomes effective on Friday, June 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Anderson County Fiscal Court has determined that it is appropriate to allow the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on specified highways within the jurisdictional boundaries of Anderson County in accordance with the Act and this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the fiscal court of county of Anderson. Commonwealth of Kentucky as follows:

## SECTION ONE

**DEFINITIONS:** The definitions set forth in Section 1(1) of the 2025 Ky. Acts ch. 89 (hereinafter "the Act"), and as may be amended in the future by the Kentucky General Assembly, are adopted and incorporated by reference as if set forth fully herein.

## SECTION TWO

**DESIGNATED HIGHWAYS:** Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall be allowed to the extent permitted by the Act on all highways that are located within the jurisdictional limits of Anderson County.

### SECTION THREE

EXCEPTIONS: Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall not be allowed to operate:

- (a) On any highway, or portion thereof, located within the jurisdictional limits of Anderson County unless allowed by this ordinance.
- (b) On any highway, or portion thereof, that is a controlled access system, including but not limited to an interstate or parkway; or
- (c) On any highway, or portion thereof, where the United States Department of Agriculture prohibits special purpose vehicles.

#### SECTION FOUR

### PROHIBITIONS:

- (a) Street-legal special purpose vehicles are prohibited from traveling a distance greater than twenty (20) miles on a highway displaying centerline pavement markings.
- (b) Minitrucks shall not be operated as street-legal special purpose vehicles on a highway that has been constructed pursuant to a federal highway program.

#### SECTION FIVE

### EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, attestation, and publication as required by law.

## **ORDINANCE # 2025—0x**

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANDERSON FISCAL COURT RELATING TO STREET-LEGAL SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLES

WHEREAS, 2025 Ky. Acts ch. 89 (hereinafter "the Act") became law on March 26, 2025 and allows for the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on certain highways within the Commonwealth of Kentucky if allowed by ordinance of the local government within whose jurisdictional boundaries the highway is located; and

WHEREAS, the Act becomes effective on Friday, June 27, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Anderson County Fiscal Court has determined that it is appropriate to allow the operation of street-legal special purpose vehicles on specified highways within the jurisdictional boundaries of Anderson County in accordance with the Act and this ordinance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** by the fiscal court of county of Anderson, Commonwealth of Kentucky as follows:

## **SECTION ONE**

**<u>DEFINITIONS</u>**: The definitions set forth in Section 1(1) of the 2025 Ky. Acts ch. 89 (hereinafter "the Act"), and as may be amended in the future by the Kentucky General Assembly, are adopted and incorporated by reference as if set forth fully herein.

## **SECTION TWO**

**<u>DESIGNATED HIGHWAYS:</u>** Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall be allowed to the extent permitted by the Act on all highways that are located within the jurisdictional limits of Anderson County.

## SECTION THREE

**EXCEPTIONS:** Street-legal special purpose vehicles shall not be allowed to operate:

- (a) On any highway, or portion thereof, located within the jurisdictional limits of Anderson County unless allowed by this ordinance.
- (b) On any highway, or portion thereof, that is a controlled access system, including but not limited to an interstate or parkway; or
- (c) On any highway, or portion thereof, where the United States Department of Agriculture prohibits special purpose vehicles.

## SECTION FOUR

## **PROHIBITIONS:**

- (a) Street-legal special purpose vehicles are prohibited from traveling a distance greater than twenty (20) miles on a highway displaying centerline pavement markings.
- (b) Minitrucks shall not be operated as street-legal special purpose vehicles on a highway that has been constructed pursuant to a federal highway program.

## **SECTION FIVE**

# **EFFECTIVE DATE:**

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, attestation, and publication as required by law.
